

LAWRENCEBURG UTILITY SYSTEM

SUBJECT: Temporary Electric Service

POLICY:

This policy is applicable where electric service is required for construction or other temporary purposes.

1. Temporary service equipment will be provided by the customer and shall be inspected and approved by the Deputy State Electrical Inspector prior to connection by LUS.
2. Temporary service equipment shall not be installed on LUS poles. The temporary service shall not be closer than 10' nor more than 100' from a LUS pole. Line extensions will not be made for temporary services unless there is reasonable assurance a permanent structure will be built or aid-to construction will be required. Each temporary service installation shall be rigidly installed in the ground with braces or guys to adequately support the overhead service conductors. They must be installed in such a way that all conductors meet the clearance requirements of all state and national electric and safety codes.
3. A non-refundable charge will be made to cover the cost of connecting and disconnecting the temporary service.
4. The billing rate for temporary services shall be the applicable General Power Rate.
5. Aid to Construction will be calculated by the LUS Engineering Department on standard cost. The cost will consist of installation labor plus removal labor, plus 20% for lost material. The calculated charges will be paid before construction of the electric service begins.
