Monitoring Violations Annual Notice Tier 3

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for Lawrenceburg Water System

Our water system violated drinking water monitoring requirements over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct these situations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the 2nd quarter of 2015 we failed to monitor for total Trihalomethanes and Total Haloacetic Acids in the week designated in our Stage 2 LRAA Monitoring Plan and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the contaminant we did not properly test for during the last year, how often we are supposed to sample for Total Trihalomethanes and Total Trihalomethanes, how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, date samples should have been taken.

What is being done?

System was late pulling the required samples by 18 days. The system is now back on track with the sampling plan. Although the samples were late we have included the test result in the consumer confidence report.
